### SUSFANS A framework for impact

### Mission

Deliver high-quality research to support evidence-based policies and innovation strategies that will fruitfully underpin a more sustainable consumption and production of food in the EU




SUSFANS aims to better inform navigation on sustainable food in the public and private arena





### SUSFANS The research strategy







### **SUSFANS**

Impact: Strengthening the analytical capacity for assessing the state of EU FNS at sub-regional level


SUSFANS delivers an integrated approach to assess sustainable food and nutrition security of the EU food system in three steps:

- 1. Development of a <u>conceptual framework</u> of the EU food system
- 2. Development of a model toolbox consisting of:
  - a) an integrated, hierarchical set of <u>metrics</u> for assessing options for change
  - b) a modelling strategy for estimating the metrics
- 3. A visualization tool (toolbox) across the metrics to enable an informed stakeholder debate on food system change.





## SUSFANS Step 1: Conceptual framework







### SUSFANS Step 2: Model Toolbox

#### Model toolbox

- 1) a micro-level modelling of nutrient intakes, habitual dietary patterns and preferences of individual consumers
- macro-level modelling of food demand and supply in the context of economic, environmental and demographic changes on various time-scales and for multiple sub-regions.

#### **Metrics**

On the sustainability performance of the EU food system in terms of nutrition, profitability, environment & equity

#### **Models**

Ranging from macro-economic and environmental assessments to micro level nutrition and spatially explicit environmental assessment





# SUSFANS Step 3: Visualizer (User Toolbox)

#### **User Toolbox**

a visualisation tool consisting of *five core elements* which can be used by stakeholders/users to benefit from the evidence-based SUSFANS research and get insight in scientific standards for assessing EU sustainable food and nutrition security to identify challenges ahead, as well as options for interventions and their tradeoffs.














# SUSFANS User Toolbox Element 5 Visualizer

#### Aim

#### Purpose


- Validate the use of the SUSFANS User Toolbox as the scientific standard for assessing EU sustainable food and nutrition security
